MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE COMPLAINT IN EXCESS OF TWENTY-FIVE PAGES

Plaintiffs, Gordon Wayne Watts, et. al., by and through undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Middle District Local Rule 3.01(d), hereby move This Honourable Court for leave to file their complaint in excess of twenty-five (25) pages, and in support thereof, state as follows:

- 1. Given the **significance of the issues involved**, as alleged—and documented—withing the "Four Corners" of the Complaint, it will exceed the limit by fifteen (15) pages, meaning complaint will be forty (40) pages total. Lead plaintiff isn't a lawyer, thus is trying his best to "follow the rules," in order to get heard on the merits—to compensate for lowly standing, so this court can be assured this motion isn't made in frivolous or bad faith fashion.
- 2. One of the plaintiffs harmed is elderly, and was made homeless by the title-theft Mortgage Fraud, based on what even the Illinois State courts admitted was basically a forged
