Assistant State Attorney, David E. Stamey, Jr. offered me a plea deal of Nolle Prosequi, in other words, a 'No Bill' of the charge, if I would accept his expensive deal (pay a hefty fine and attend a MILESTONES class). I remember vividly telling him that the report on which my arrest (& charges) were based, was a false report <u>-e.g., perjury</u> & I wished the charges dropped, and I would fight the charges & go to trial, but when my public defender told me my Constitutional 'trial jury' rights would not be afforded me (for reasons still unclear to me), I took the deal offered, since I did not want a worse (malicious prosecution) false charge on my record.-Gordon W.
