Thank you for contacting me regarding H.R. 4929, the Enduring Justice for Victims of Trafficking Act.

H.R. 4929 permanently extends the Justice for Victims of Trafficking Act of 2015, mandating the collection of a \$5,000 special assessment from persons convicted of certain federal offenses related to human trafficking and sexual exploitation. Funds from this special assessment are to be deposited into the Domestic Trafficking Victims Fund operated by the Department of Justice.
